Eligibility and General Information

1. Applicant must be a full-time Payson, AZ resident and must be graduating during the current school year from:
 - Payson High School, Payson Center for Success, an accredited online or charter high school, or an accredited home high school.
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA. An official high school transcript must be attached to the application.
3. Applicant must complete the essay questions completely and succinctly.

5. Non-fillable applications can be obtained on the PHS website and must be typed.
6. Mail completed applications to: NGCHS, PO Box 2579, Payson, AZ 85547.
7. **No handwritten or hand printed applications will be accepted.**
8. **Applications must be received by April 1. No late applications will be accepted.**
9. This scholarship is payable upon proof of enrollment of the student in an accredited college, university, technical, or vocational school. Upon proof of enrollment, the check will be presented to the student.
