## **Administrative History**

Tonto Trails magazine was started in 1955 by Norman Mead, who later also published the Arizona's White Mountains magazine. Tonto Trails was issued once a year, and initially cost 25 cents. The magazine provided articles about Rim Country and its happenings, such as a "fish derby" on Tonto Creek and how to make beef jerky.

Norman Mead was the son of Maynard Mead, who in 1939 purchased 40 acres under the Mogollon Rim that later became a development known as Mead's Ranch. Norman's love of the outdoors is clearly seen through his many publications and photographs. His maps anchored the magazine, and one became a popular placemat used in Rim Country throughout the years at places such as Aunt Alice's (today's Gerardo's) and the Beeline Café.

While *Tonto Trails* magazine eventually ceased publication, Norman's son Russell continues to publish *Arizona's White Mountains* magazine and other materials.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of issues of the *Tonto Trails* magazine printed between 1957 and 2000. Issues focused on the Payson-Pine-Strawberry, Tonto Basin, Globe, and Apache Trail areas.
