Administrative/Biographical History

After retiring in 1991 as a United Methodist pastor, Stanley C. Brown continued his avocation of research and writing regional history. In 1993 he and his wife Ruth made their permanent home in Payson, and for twelve years he was appointed by the Town of Payson as its official historian. He served a number of years on the board of directors for the Northern Gila County Historical Society, including a time as its president, and developed the first historical archive for the Rim Country Museum. He has written weekly and bi-weekly columns for the *Payson Roundup* and has had numerous papers published in the *Journal of Arizona History* and several books on Rim Country history published by the Northern Gila County Historical Society, Inc.

This collection consists of 56 cassette tapes of interviews with 45 individuals. All interviews were digitized in 2016.
