Biographical History

Harold "Hal" Hulbert was with the Forest Service from 1922 to 1953. During that time he served in New Mexico, the Spring Valley District of the Tusayan National Forest, and the Mazatzal Ranger District of the Tonto National Forest, and helped to build the Control road under the Mogollon Rim. He also helped manage the Camp Geronimo Boy Scout Ranch. In 1948 he and his wife Addie Lea purchased a ranch in Bray Creek and lived there for 28 years, selling it as Harold's health declined.

Scope and Content

The bulk of the collection consists of documents pertaining to a portion of Hulbert's time with the Forest Service and his retirement; there is also some information about Harold and Addie Lea's marriage, and an interview with Harold conducted in 1976. Materials include professional correspondence, work-time reports, contracts, newspaper clippings, photographs, an interview transcript, miscellaneous papers and ephemera.
